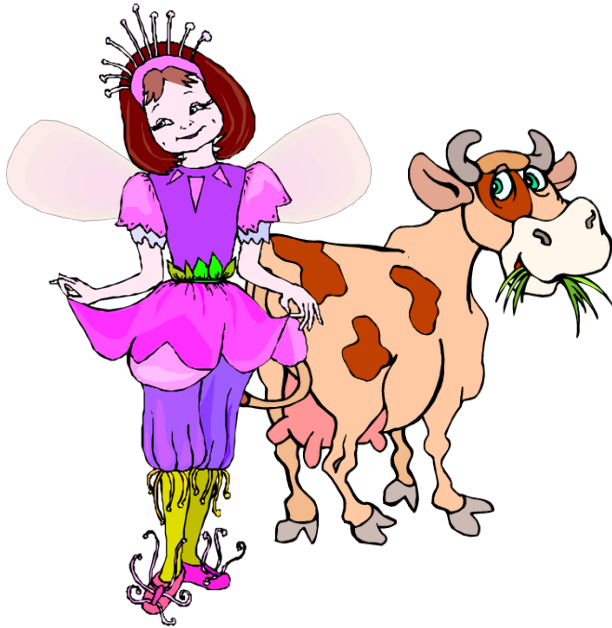


Q Have you ever seen a bowtie on a crow?
